Trophies & Diplomas: There will be a senior classification, a junior classification, a female

classification and an eagle classification. Every classification requires a minimum of 4 pilots flying at least one round. A competitor is considered to be a junior up to and including the calendar year in which he attains the age of 18. A competitor is considered to be an eagle from the

calendar year in which he attains the age of 55. Trophies will be given to the first three places.

Admission terms: Competitors have to provide an insurance and a valid FAI license for

2025.
